

Our Savior Lutheran Church (OSLC) Timeline from 1983-2018

| 1983 | St. Paul's Lutheran Church and St. Mark's Lutheran Church of Minot met in the spring of 1983 to discuss the start of a new mission church in South Minot. "South Minot Lutheran Church" met for the first time in September 1983 in the gymnasium of Edison School. Pastor Bard Garrison served as Senior Pastor from 1983-1985. |
| 1985 | Pastor Timothy Cartwright came to serve as Senior Pastor starting in 1985. The church chose its new name "Our Savior Lutheran Church." Bonnie Rennich was hired part-time as Director of Music. |
| 1986 | Our original building was built in 1986 with the help of Laborers for Christ and many of our own congregation members. The dedication service was on September 14, 1986. |
| 1987 | Gen Spletto and Connie Strandberg served as Church Secretaries in the early years. |
| 1988 | Pastor Clark Jahnke came to serve as Senior Pastor in 1988. |
| 1993 | Pastor Paul Krueger served as Senior Pastor from 1993 until February 2018. |
| 1994 | By the end of 1994, attendance had greatly increased and OSLC began holding both traditional and contemporary worship services. |
| 1996 | Peggy Trondson began serving as Church Secretary in 1996 and retired in 2017. |
| 1998 | With a strong focus on our youth, Deb Hoiland was hired as our Director of Youth Ministries. |
| 1999 | Sue Jensen served as our Director of Children's Ministry from 1999-2002. |
| 2000 | An addition was added featuring a new kitchen and sanctuary. The dedication for this addition was 09/10/2000. |
| 2002 | Gary Granzotto served as Ministry Assistant from 2002-2003. |
| 2003 | Lori Wintermute served as Director of Youth Ministries from August 2003 until August 2007. |
| 2004 | An education wing with large gathering space and classrooms was added. The dedication service was 09/19/2004. |
| 2005 | Pastor Thomas Eaves served as Assistant Pastor from 2005-2006. |
| 2006 | With worship attendance growing fast, a third worship service was added in April 2006. |
| 2007 | The vicarage program began in 2007 with Vicar Andy Busch serving from 2007-2008. Bonnie Rennich hired full-time as Director of Music and Congregational Ministries. |
| 2008 | Our Savior Lutheran Church started the Stephen Ministry program in 2008. Shana Erie was hired as our Director of Youth Ministries in 2008. Vicar Anders Davidson served from 2008-2009. |
| 2009 | Vicar Rick Jones served from 2009-2010. |
| 2010 | Little Hands Loving Hearts Child Development Center was opened in January 2010. Pastor Daniel Voth served as Assistant Pastor from February 2010 until February 2016. Vicar Josh Baumann served from 2010-2011. |
| 2011 | Vicar Ben Carnahan served from 2011-2012. |
| 2012 | Following Minot's devastating flood, Hope Village was established at OSLC, serving as the focal point for volunteers. OSLC coordinated 9 faith-based recovery organizations, managed 5200 volunteers from 42 states who rebuilt more than 540 flood-damaged homes. Pastor Andy Busch served as Assistant Pastor from 2012-2015 and Spiritual Care Pastor for flood victims in 2012. He moved to part-time Youth Ministry Director from 2015-2017. |
| 2015 | Betsy Jones was hired as Administrative Assistant to the Senior Pastor in July 2015. Betsy's role was expanded to include Communications Coordinator and Secretary to the Governing Board. Brittany Busch served as Children's Ministry Coordinator from September 2015 to July 2016. |
| 2016 | Vicar David LaFore served from 2016-2017. Nancy Graham served as Children's Ministry Director from July 2016 to July 2017. Joelle Schaan started as Youth Ministry Coordinator in 2016. |
| 2017 | Vicar Matthew Albright served from 2017-2018. Joelle Schaan served as Children's Ministry Director from October 2017 until March 2018. |
| 2018 | Pastor Rick Jones served as Vacancy Pastor from February through September 2018. Pam Trueblood began serving as Administrative Secretary in February 2018. Sue Dodd was hired in 2018 to serve as Director of Children's and Family Ministry. Marsha DesLauriers began serving as Administrative Assistant in September 2018. Rev. Dr. Richard Davis was installed on 9/23/18 as OSLC's Intentional Interim Minister. |
