## Week of Hope 2020 – Loveland, CO

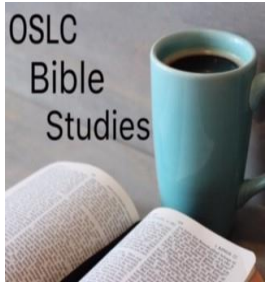
