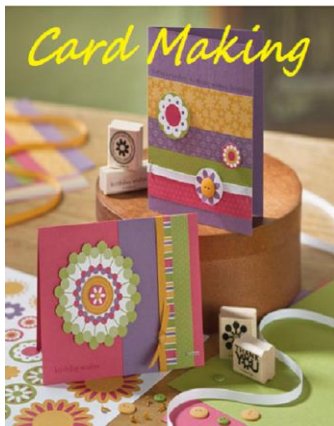

# 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Governing Board Meeting



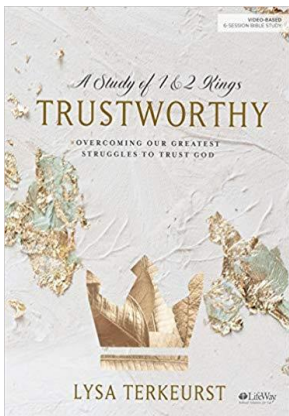

At this point, we don't plan to provide childcare but if the need arises, we will do our best to meet that need.

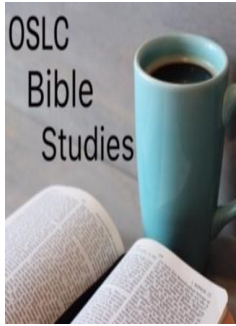
## Save the Date: Ladies Movie Night Sat. Jan 25
