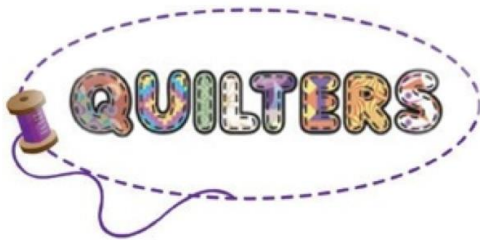
Annual Winter Ski Retreat

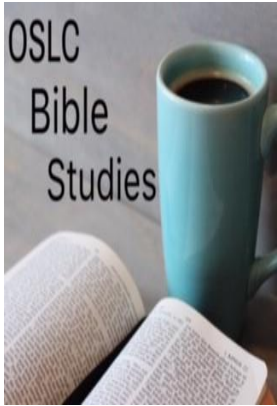
