Adult Mission Bake Sale



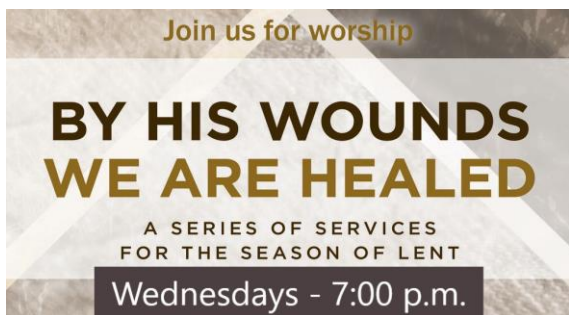
