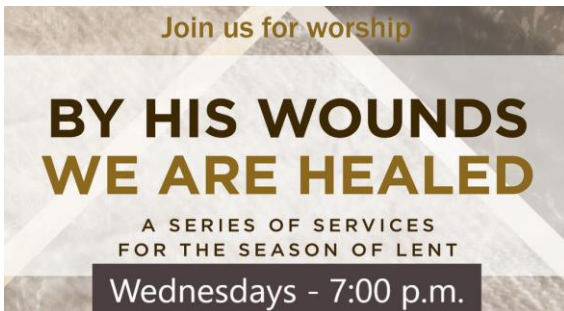

FROGS – 5:30-5:55 p.m.

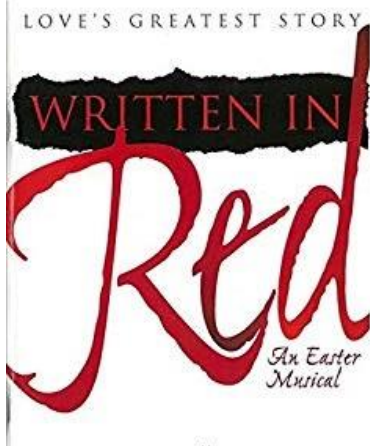
Confirmation/GLo/N.U.T.S – 6:00-6:55 p.m.

Worship – 7:00 p.m.

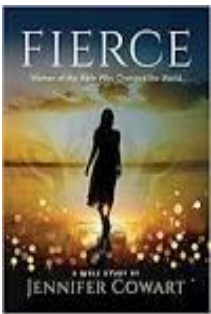

## Easter Cantata – Want to Join Us?

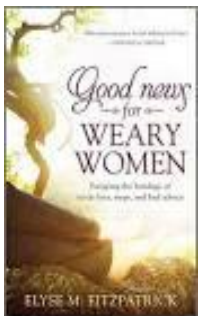

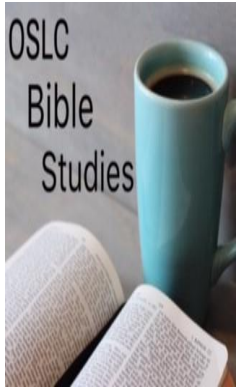
