Worship – 7:00 p.m.

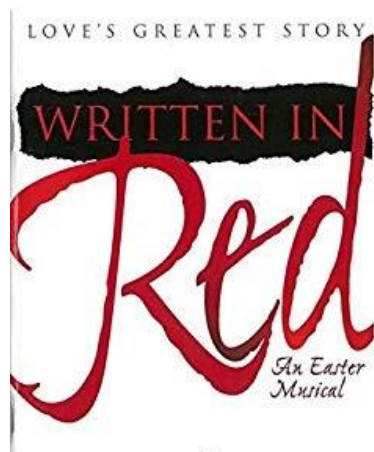

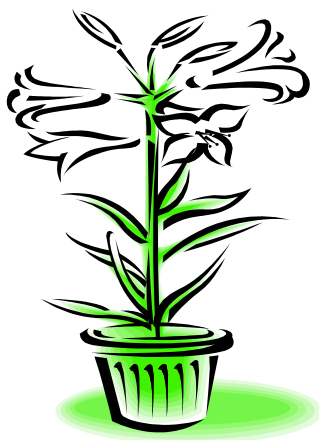

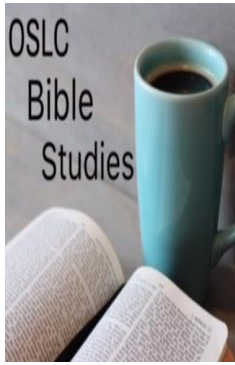
## Can You Help?
