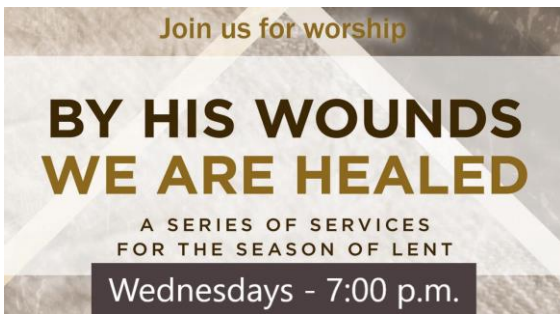

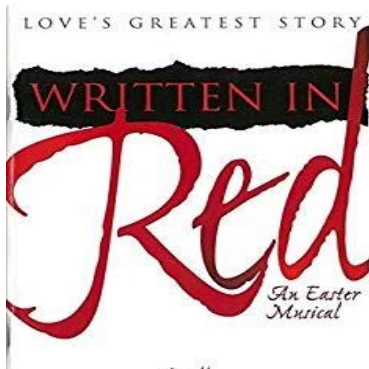

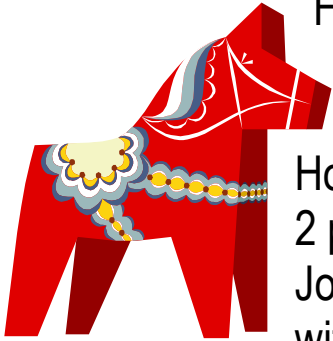


## Greeter Ministry

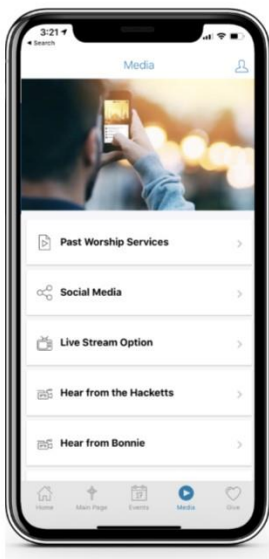
