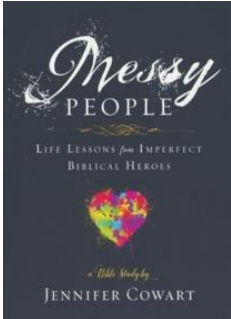

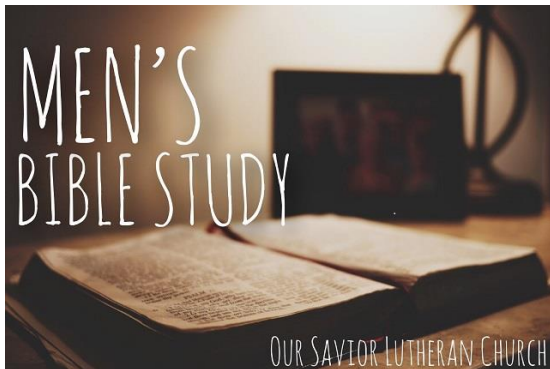

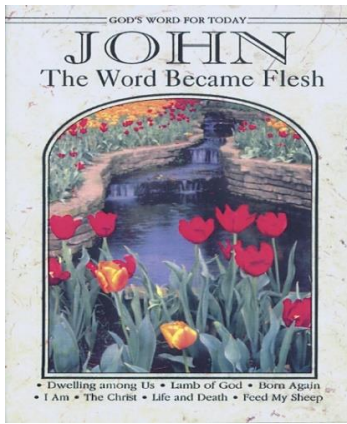
## Saturday Morning Men’s Bible Study via Zoom

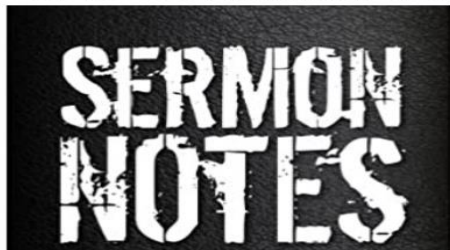

## Resource Bench



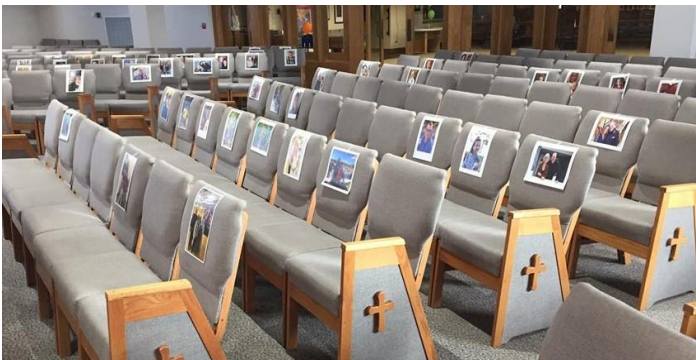
