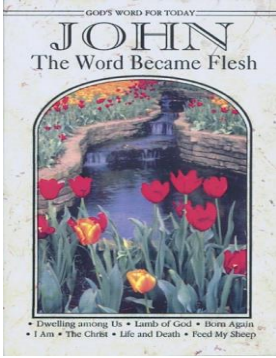

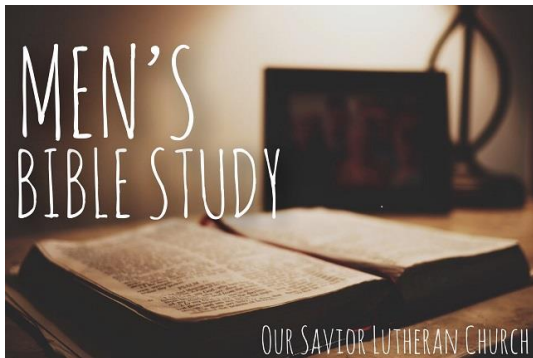
## Pastor-led Bible Study – You Can Still Join

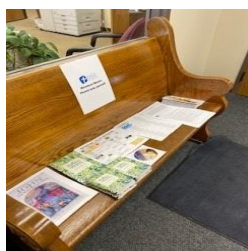
