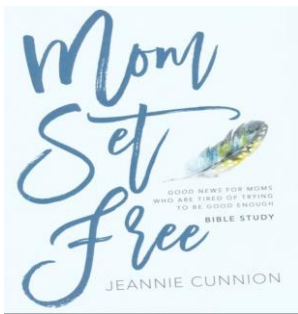

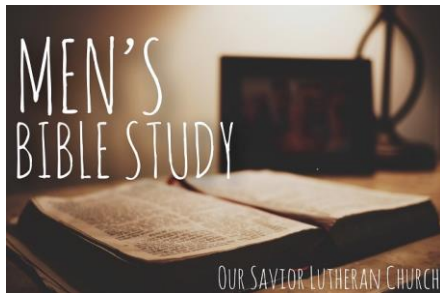


New Women's Bible Study



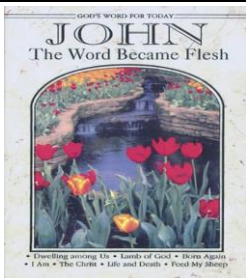
