1983	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪In the spring of 1983, St. Paul's Lutheran Church and St. Mark's Lutheran Church of Minot met and discussed starting a new mission church in South Minot. ▪"South Minot Lutheran Church" first met in September 1983 in Edison School's gymnasium. ▪Rev. Bard Garrison served as Senior Pastor from 1983-1985.
1985	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Timothy Cartwright served as Senior Pastor from September 1985 to August 1988. ▪In 1985, the church chose its new name "Our Savior Lutheran Church." ▪Bonnie Rennich was hired part-time to serve as Director of Music in 1985.
1986	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Our original building was built in 1986 with the help of Laborers for Christ and many of our own congregation members with dedication service on 09/14/86.
1987	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Gen Spletto and Connie Strandberg served as Church Secretaries in the early years.
1988	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Kenneth Jenks served as Vacancy Pastor from August 1988 to July 1989.
1989	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Clark Jahnke was ordained and installed 07/09/89 and served as Senior Pastor until May 1992.
1992	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Kenneth Jenks served as Vacancy Pastor from May 1992 to September 1993.
1993	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Paul Krueger served as Senior Pastor from September 1993 to February 2018.
1994	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪By the end of 1994, attendance had greatly increased and OSLC began holding both traditional and contemporary worship services.
1996	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Deb Hoiland served as Youth Leader in 1996 and was later hired as Director of Youth Ministries where she served from October 1997 to September 1999.
1997	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Peggy Trondson served as Church Secretary from January 1997 until retirement in December 2017.
1999	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Sue Jensen served as our Director of Children's Ministry from 1999-2002.
2000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪An addition was added featuring a new kitchen and sanctuary with dedication service on 09/10/2000.
2002	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Gary Granzotto served as Ministry Assistant from 2002-2003.
2003	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Lori Wintermute served as Director of Youth Ministries from August 2003 until August 2007.
2004	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪An education wing with large gathering space and classrooms was added with dedication service on 09/19/2004.
2005	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Rev. Thomas Eaves served as Assistant Pastor from 2005-2006.
2006	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪With worship attendance growing fast, a third worship service was added in April 2006.
2007	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪The Vicarage Program began in August 2007. ▪Andrew (Andy) Busch was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/12/07 and served his vicarage year from 2007-2008. ▪Bonnie Rennich began serving full-time as Director of Music and Congregational Ministries in 2007.
2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪The Stephen Ministry program started in 2008. ▪Shana Erie served as our Director of Youth Ministries from June 2008 to April 2009. ▪Anders Davidson was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/10/08 and served his vicarage year from 2008-2009.
2009	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Richard (Rick) Jones was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/16/09 and served his vicarage year from 2009-2010.
2010	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Little Hands Loving Hearts Child Development Center opened in January 2010. ▪Rev. Daniel (Dan) Voth served as Assistant Pastor from February 2010 until February 2016. ▪Joshua (Josh) Baumann was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/08/10 and served his vicarage year from 2010-2011.
2011	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Benjamin (Ben) Carnahan was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/21/11 and served his vicarage year from 2011-2012. ▪Rudy Steinke served doing General Maintenance from September 2011 to September 2015.
2012	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Following Minot's devastating flood, Hope Village was established at OSLC coordinating 9 faith-based recovery organizations and managing 5200 volunteers from 42 states who rebuilt more than 540 flood-damaged homes. ▪Steve Carbo served as Hope Village Manager from July 2012 to December 2013. ▪Rev. Andrew (Andy) Busch was installed on 06-10-12 and served as Spiritual Care Pastor for flood victims and Assistant Pastor until August 2015. He moved to part-time Youth Ministry Director from August 2015 to August 2017.
2013	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪The Governing Board under Policy-Based Governance was established (replacing the Board of Directors) in June 2013.
2014	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪The People Care Team was established in 2014.
2015	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Elizabeth (Betsy) Jones began serving as Administrative Assistant to the Senior Pastor in July 2015. Betsy's role was expanded to include Communications Coordinator and Secretary to the Governing Board.

2016	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Aaron Jung served doing General Maintenance from January 2016 to August 2016. ▪David LaFore was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 08/07/16 and served his vicarage year from 2016-2017. ▪Nancy Graham served as Children's Ministry Director from August 2016 to July 2017. ▪Joelle Schaan served as Young Adult Ministry Coordinator expanding to Youth Ministry Coordinator from September 2016 through June 2020 (and also served as Children's Ministry Director from October 2017 to March 2018).
2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪Matthew (Matt) Albright was installed as Vicar (Seminary Intern) on 07/23/17 and served his vicarage year from 2017-2018. ▪Rob Warath served doing General Maintenance from August 2017 to January 2019. ▪Marsha DesLauriers served as Administrative Assistant in December 2017 and was later hired in September 2018.

Richard (Rick) Jones served as Vacancy Pastor from February to September 2018. ▪Pamela (Pam) Trueblood served as Administrative Secretary from February 2018 to December 2019. ▪The Mercy Care Ministry was established by the Board of Elders in February 2018. ▪Susan (Sue) Dodd served as Family and Children's Ministry Coordinator from May 2018 to February 2020. ▪Rev. Dr. Richard Davis was installed on 09/23/18 as Intentional Interim Minister and served until September 2019.
