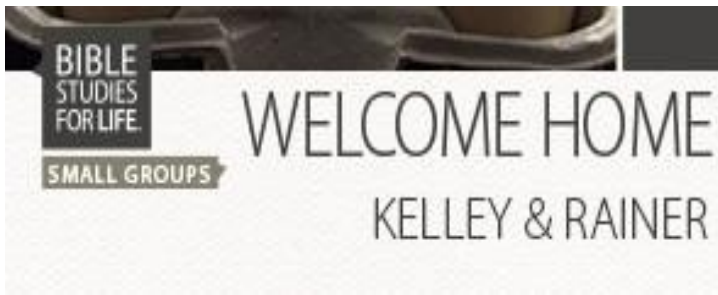

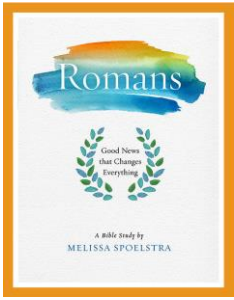
Join us for another PMS event, sponsored by the OSLC Women's Ministry Team.

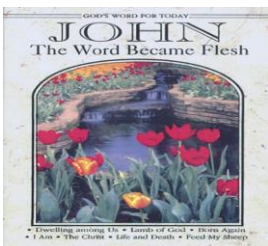
## Lutheran Witness Subscription
