Sewing Disciples Tomorrow



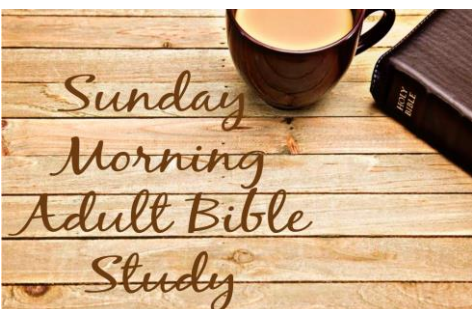

Additional Opportunity for Holy Communion



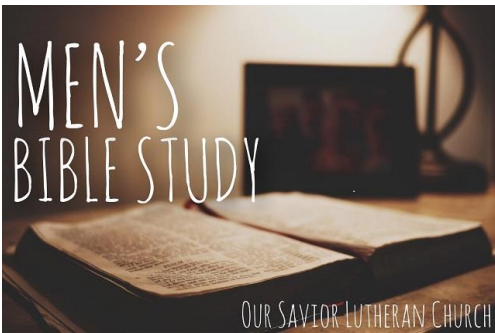
