Burritos for Bambinos Today

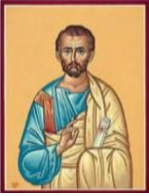

Be a Barnabas Buddy

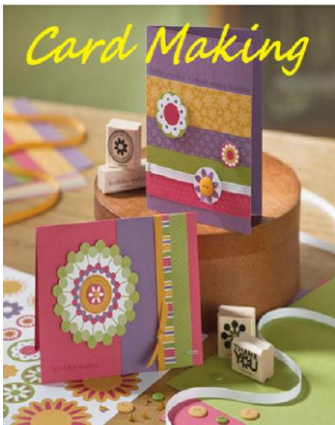

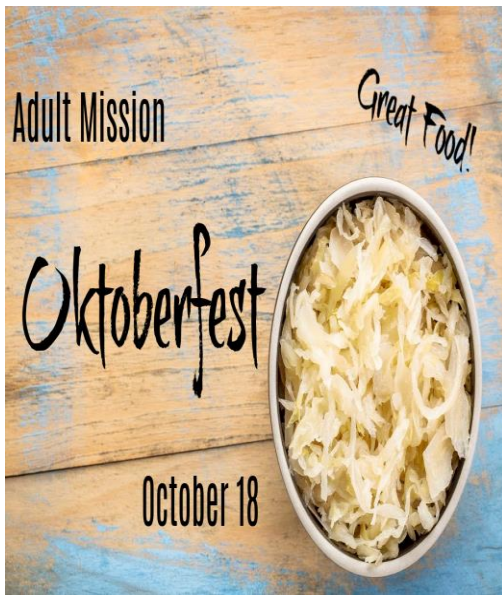
OSLC Family Day at Berry Acres

Please keep all of our staff and church family in your prayers. There are so many activities taking place each and every week and we need the Lord's guidance as we continue to move forward in ministry.

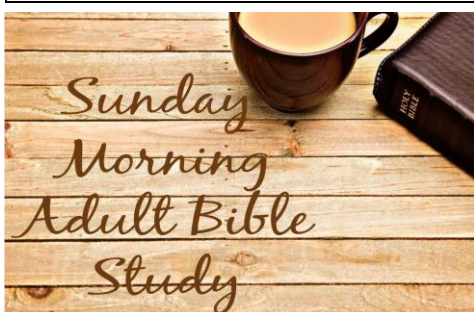
Additional Opportunity for Holy Communion

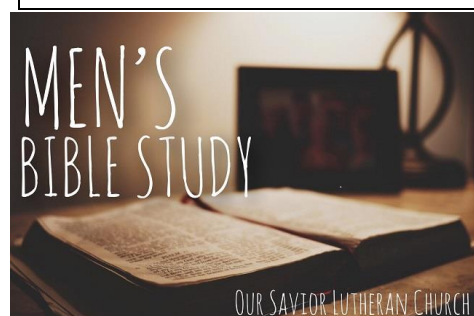

Holy Communion at Our Savior Lutheran Church

2. Do I believe that Christ gives me His true body and blood in this sacrament for the forgiveness of my sins?
3. Do I promise, with the help of the Holy Spirit, to amend my sinful life?
4. Do I share a oneness in faith with the church body with which I am about to commune?

If you have difficulty answering "yes" to any of the above questions, please follow the guide of Scripture and wait to take communion today. Our Pastor would be glad to visit with you in preparation for the next time Holy Communion is offered.

Non-alcoholic wine is available for those with alcohol sensitivities.

Please signal your desire to the Pastor by briefly holding your hand in the "stop" position before receiving the cup. Gluten Free wafers are available.
