Senior High Youth



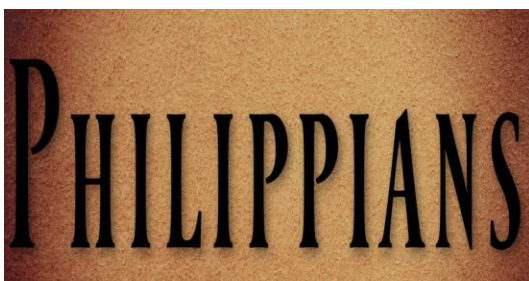

New Ladies Study Begins Jan 19, 2021



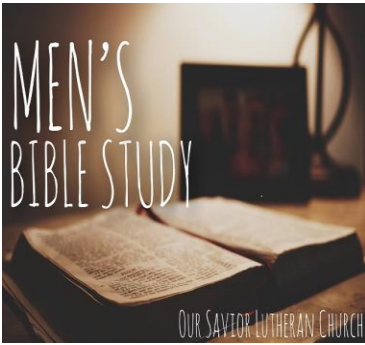

Philippians Bible Study



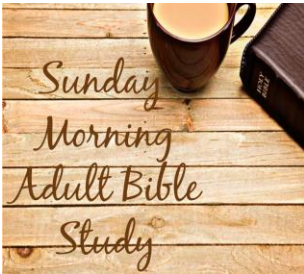
