The following will be in effect through January 2021, and will be evaluated regularly. ***For all activities in the church building during the month of January, masks and social distancing are required.*** What a blessing it will be to return to the activities of the church! We are grateful for your continued patience and prayers, moving forward.

- **WORSHIP:** We will continue worshipping physically, wearing masks and social distancing, each Sunday morning at 8:15, 9:30, and 11:00. We will still offer online worship opportunities via Facebook and YouTube.
- **COMMUNION:** Communion will be offered from 1:00-2:30 on the 1st and 3rd Sundays.
- **FELLOWSHIP:** We will return to coffee/drink service on Sunday mornings, but will hold off on food service until further notice.
- **BIBLE STUDY:** The following Bible studies will resume in January: Men’s Saturday AM Study (1/9); Sunday AM John Study (1/10); Sunday School (1/10); Women’s Wednesday AM Study (1/13); Women’s Tuesday PM Study (1/19); Women’s Thursday PM Study (1/21). There will be physical *and* virtual options for some of these, so please contact your group leader or the church office for more information.
- **WEDNESDAY EVENING:** OSKids, Confirmation, and Senior Youth Group will all resume on 1/6. There will be no meal served in January, but snacks will be provided.
- **BUILDING USAGE:** For meetings and other activities, we are encouraging best safety practices. Resuming these activities, with masks and social distancing, is allowed and encouraged.
