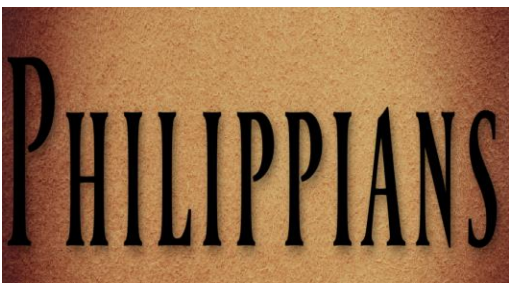

New Ladies Study Begins Tuesday



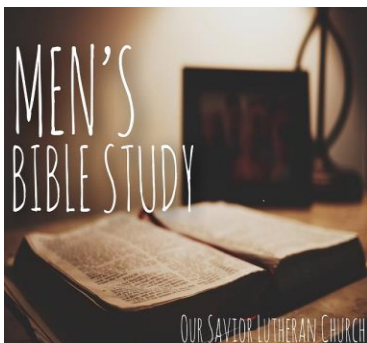

Philippians Bible Study Begins Thursday



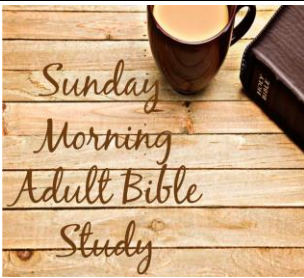

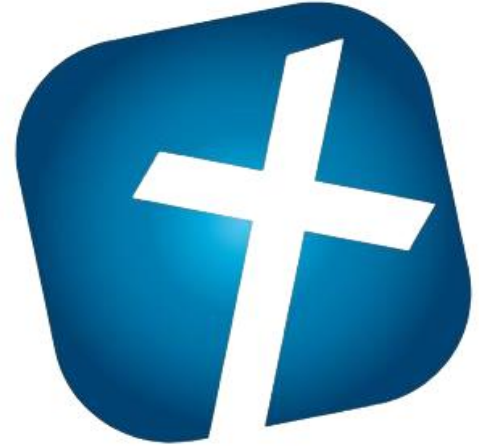
