7th – 8th Grade Skate Event



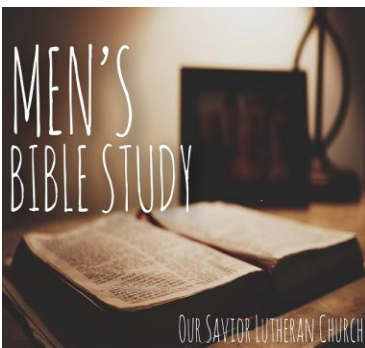

1st Quarter Governing Board Meeting



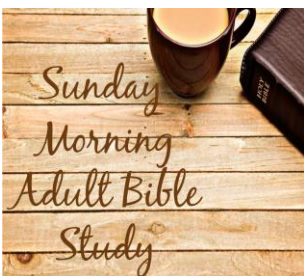
