Hall. Cost is \$5.00 per person or \$15.00 per family.

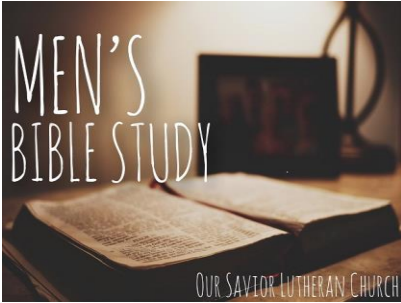
2021 Trivia Night at the Grand!

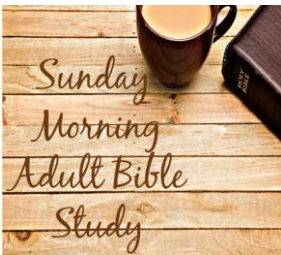
