## Easter Lilies



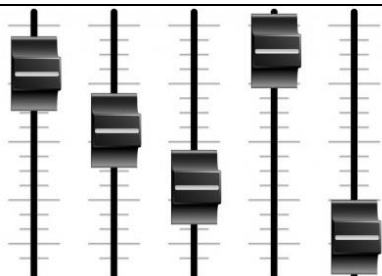

## Women's Painting Event



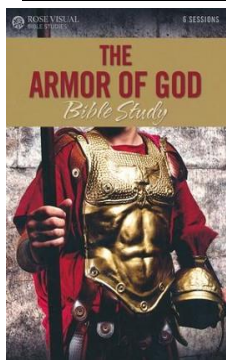

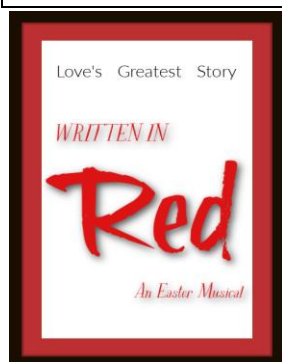

## Hostfest Chairpersons Needed



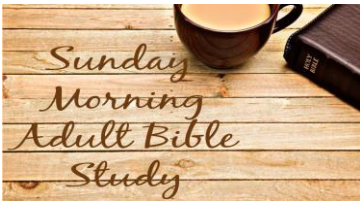
