## Wednesday Meal Sign-up



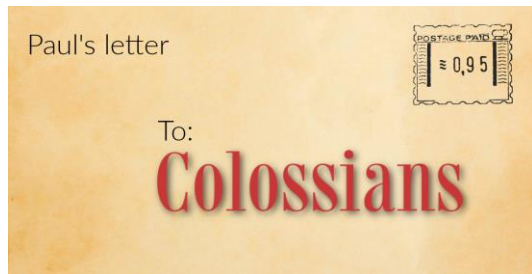

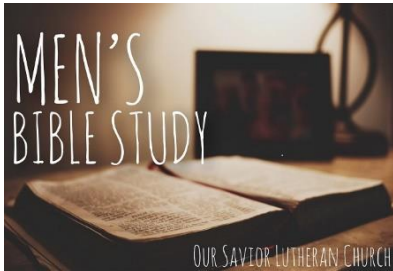

## Wednesday Women's Study



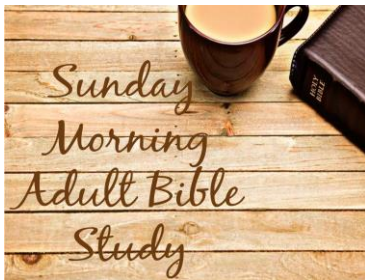
